

Minnesota Adult Basic Education Support Network

State statute designates three percent of the state ABE appropriation to support “supplemental services”. The purpose of these statewide supplemental services grants is to provide assistance to all approved local ABE programs, creating effective and efficient services. Seven activities and six providers are approved for 2018-19.
