Hiring for Tier 1

Initial

Job must be posted for 15 days on EdPost

Justification for hire:

- 1. No Tier 2, 3, or 4 teachers applied for the position
- 2. No Tier 2, 3, or 4 teachers accepted the position
- 3. No Tier 2, 3, or 4 teacher was acceptable based on one of the following:
 - 1. Not fluent in the language
 - 2. Unwilling to abide by pedagogical model of school
 - 3. Disciplinary action with PELSB or district
 - 4. Not willing to abide by culturally responsive teaching
 - 5. Poor references

Hiring for Tier 1

Renewal

Job must be posted for 60 days on EdPost

First Renewal:

- 1. Teacher must have attempted applicable MTLE content exams
- 2. The district must attest the teacher has:
 - 1. Completed cultural competency training
 - 2. Participated in a mentorship program
 - 3. Completed an evaluation
 - 4. Must also have justification for re-hire

Candidate	Bachelor's/CTE: MA or Enrolled in Prep or Two of
Application	Affirm a job offer, does not need justification

Renewal

1 year extension	Reminder- all licenses were extended by one year
5 year license	All valid licenses were converted to Tier 4 on July 1
1 year license	Must pass pedagogy and content exams for Tier 3, if not, must have district job offer in content area for Tier 2
ССТ	Training must address all components: racial, cultural, and socioeconomic groups; American Indian and Alaskan native students; religion; systemic racism; gender identity, including transgender students; sexual orientation; language diversity; and individuals with disabilities and mental health concerns.

Rulemaking

- Proposed changes to ABE rule (8710.4000)
 - Most notable is exempting ABE teacher candidates from 12 weeks of student teaching
- PELSB is currently seeking public comment on proposed rule draft
 - Submit feedback on PELSB's website (mn.gov/pelsb), or email Michelle Vaught, Rulemaking Specialist (<u>michelle.Vaught@state.mn.us</u>)
 - No "end date" for submitting comments
- Will be at least one more draft made available before next step in the process
